- There is a minimum passing **test out** score (C+ or better).
- Students who successfully **test out** of a course shall be awarded credit on the transcript and the grade will not count toward the student's GPA.
- Students may wish to log into www.michigan.gov/mde to learn more about the courses at the high school level and what will be assessed on the **test out** exam. Once on the site, look for *Curriculum, Subjects*, then the specific Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC) course. Teachers are not available in the summer for instruction.
- It is the student's responsibility to email teacher and obtain course materials from the designated teacher the last week of May (see Test Out Teacher List on the back of this form).
- Students may only attempt to test out of a specific class one time.
- Results will be communicated to student prior to the first week of school by the teacher.
- **Note:** If a student signs up for testing out and then over the summer decides to not follow through with the program, there will be a \$30 charge that will go to the teacher for the time, trouble, and cost of materials prepared for the student initially.
